

COVID-19 VACCINATION INFORMATION

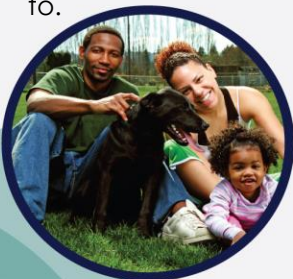
Phase 2 of the vaccination rollout started on Monday the 17th of May. We are now one month down the line and many of our members who registered have already been vaccinated. Please take note of the following information :

YOU RECEIVED YOUR FIRST DOSE OF THE VACCINE

- If you have received your first dose of the Pfizer vaccine then you will have received an SMS supplying you with your unique vaccination code. It is important to keep this information safely.
- You would also have been informed that your second dose will be administered to you 42 days after your first shot.
- You will be sent an SMS to remind you to go and get this second dose. It will not be given out sooner than the 42 days.
- It is very important to ensure you get the second dose to gain maximum immunity.
- If you received the Johnson and Johnson vaccine no second dose is required.
- If you have had the vaccine it is still possible to get infected, please continue with all the non-pharmaceutical measures of wearing a mask, social distancing, sanitising and avoiding closed spaces with too many people.

YOU REGISTERED BUT HAVE NOT BEEN VACCINATED

- You should have received an SMS to inform you that you are registered.
- The EVDS system will send you an SMS with a voucher and tell you which venue to go to.



COVID-19 VACCINATION INFORMATION

- Although registered walk ins are being accepted at some sites you are not guaranteed getting your vaccination on that day. Those with vouchers have preference. You could queue and not be able to get the vaccine that day. It is completely dependent on vaccine supply at that particular site.
- Waiting for your invitation via SMS is the safest. Invitations are sent out to those who registered first.
- **It is important to note that no schemes are being given preferential treatment with access to vaccines. Everyone is being administered through the national EVDS system.**

REGISTER FOR THE VACCINE

For those over the age of 60 who have not yet registered for the vaccine on the EVDS system this is a reminder on the different ways in which you can register:

- **The toll free national hotline link 0800 029 999** can be used. Phone between 08.00 and 18.00 seven days a week.
- You will receive an SMS from the EVDS system to confirm your registration.
